3rd Thames R P & J Thomas 1422 with a very well bred pigeon the sire is a son of a St Philberts national winner and the dam has been 1st section guernsey 2nd section Bordeaux Paul is hoping this bird matures to a good distance pigeon.

4/5th the Thames secretary Rachael bacon 1422/1421. Rachael's 1st bird a raf claes x a granddaughter of mark gilberts RPRA winner. 5th Thames a mealy hen Johnny pains x raf claes which is a full sister to m Symonds ubi combine winner.

6/9/10th goodliffe & Simmons 1418/1417x2. Lee had a lambrecht followed by 2 frans zwols all home bred.

Winning 8th Thames Gladwin Jarvis & family 1418 with a fantastic 3 yr old hen which is the last to be bred from the dream pair. Raced 33 times over 6000 miles as an old bird been 1st to the loft on 6 occasions 3 of them from channel races shows what a great pigeon she is. Johns birds have had the minimum of training and loft exercise of late. She was entered for Tarbes but owing to very unfortunate family issues she went to stoneycross.

Liberation 2 race 19A for the shorter flyers 76 to 105 miles went up at 9.15am

Taking the first 3 Joe Hobin 1506 / 1505 x 2. 1st to register by the smallest of margins a granddaughter of shadows image a couple of seconds behind another two vandenbeeles all bred from mark Evans stock.

4/5/6th Kirk bullen 1502 x 3 first to register a Young blue ck paired to a tippler his box a canary



cage!! Bred from a McDonaugh bulk ck with 4 wins x Kirk's dad's bicc national winner. 2 nd over the pad a Ricky Warner x sayer bros with the 3rd bred by Ricky Warner.

7th/ 9th 1464/1454 P Jackson & son.

8th/10th 1453 x 2 D Wilton & son their first bird bred by ray Roberts from syndicate lofts stock. 10th place another well bred young bird the sire a son of mark bulleds famous legacy the dam is the Barcelona hen.
