2/3rd 1847 x 2 Mr consistent Tony Buckfield who has flown a team of yearling hens all season with great success. First to register has 6 top tens 2nd to register has 4 all this season great pigeons.





4/5/6th 1845 x 3 Dave & Lee Bastone 1st over the pad inbred to proper Rick, 2nd identical time a Zwols x proper Rick lines and in 6th renagade x Thomas 6 lines.

7/8th D Wilton & Son with two birds bred in the purple, the first to register is from a hen which is direct Pierre beyl inbred to super vale. 8th Thames whose sire is a direct David peeters when paired to a hen purchased from the flanders collection bred from a son of blizzard king kittle.

9/10th 1843 x 2 Topp & Mann who continue their impressive start with

young birds having 1st/2nd/3rd/
1st/2nd/3rd 9/10th Thames in the last 3 races.
Great flying. These 2 rudi van reeths
(blinky bloodlines) bred by Kerry mellonby of
Bridlington who supplied the partnership with 20
ybs and have had an instant impact.

Another fantastic race with only 5 yards separating the top ten same as race 20.
